ADDITIONAL A.G.S. DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Select courses to complete the required **minimum 96 of 64** semester hours from general education courses, elective courses, and occupational/vocational courses to a maximum of ~~63~~ **33-36 semester** hours.

Satisfy graduation requirements for all associate's degrees.

Earn no more than ~~65~~ **42 semester** credits by demonstrated competence **through the Advanced Placement Program (AP), the subject examinations of the College Level Examination Program (CLEP) and the College of DuPage Proficiency Through an Instructor Program. (Note: Brings this wording in line with specific wording in other degrees.)**

Earn no more than ~~6~~ **4 semester** credits from Physical Education activity courses.

~~Earn no more than 45 credits in courses numbers 188 and 288 (successor numbers needed).~~

~~Earn no more than 8 credits in courses numbered 198 (successor numbers needed).~~

Earn no more than **16 semester credits in courses numbered 188/288, 198/298, 190/290** (successor numbers needed).

Note: this addition clarifies this degree's compliance with ICCB rules that no more than _ of the credit applied toward a degree may come from independent study or selected topics courses.

Earn no more than ~~20~~ **12 semester** credits in courses graded satisfactory/fail.
